



## Using the Powerful LEAD App in Ministry

As we continue to move forward with our Partners in the Gospel Phase 0 into Phase 1, a helpful tool that can be of great assistance to parish leaders is the LEAD app found on both Google Play and Apple stores. The LEAD app provides leadership with the tools they need to communicate with and manage groups and people they serve "on the go." Access follows your permissions in the ChMS. When configured, it allows leaders to organize groups cross parishes and communicate to groups with parishioners from other parishes or within their parish family.

## Who can use the LEAD App?

- Admin Privilege (any Admin privilege assigned to a Profile)
- Group Leader (both Main and Assistant leaders)
- Event Organizer
- Pastoral Care Needs Coordinator
- Volunteer Schedule Organizer
- Ministry Leads
- Key Volunteers
- Queue Managers
- Form Managers
- Any 'Leadership Role' e.g. Pastor, Volunteer Coordinator, etc. (the ones set on the Campus Settings page)
