Are you unaware that we who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death?


We were indeed buried with him through baptism into death, so that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might live in newness of life.



As I go about the work of administration, reveal to me the ways in which this Paschal pattern permeates every aspect of my ministry.


Help me to tell the difference between suffering I should avoid and suffering I should embrace in fidelity to the vocation you have chosen for me.




