If you currently have other language options in your picklist that do not closely match on a 1-to-1 basis, please be sure to combine these with the appropriate one that matches it in our new system list on page 1.

To do this, use the COMBINE LANGUAGES button. We want to use the COMBINE process instead of the Delete process, so that we can replace the value on each member with the new picklist values. Using the COMBINE process, we can replace the legacy value with the proper value for use in the new system.
