

Pushpay/ParishStaq Update

We now have 47 “Campuses” involved in the Implementation Process!

Our Pilot Wave and Early Adopter Wave participants continue their implementation of ParishStaq. As of the release date for this C2P article, we have over 90,000 individual member profiles from these first 23 sites. Starting this week, they will be joined by 24 new participants in Waves 4 and 5. Expect the number of individual member profiles to double as the databases for Waves 4 and 5 get loaded in the next few weeks.

As of December 7th, our Pilot locations had over 150 groups set up and close to 9,000 events scheduled. In addition, there are numerous volunteer and liturgical minister opportunities set up and members have been scheduled. The Pilots continue to leverage the custom Forms capabilities to create registration forms for various classes and Sacramental Prep opportunities.

The LEAD app has been used to check in the volunteers for their serving opportunities. Many thanks to the hard work from all the staff members and trusted volunteers from Holy Family (Kirkland), Sacred Heart (Battleground) and its mission, St. Joseph the Worker (Yacolt) for all this progress.

Some Interesting Developments

With the 23 sites we have loaded in ParishStaq, we are starting to see how members are involved in multiple locations. One example has a family in four different campuses. The example plays out:

- that they are ‘registered’ at one location
- have donated at two others, and
- volunteer at a fourth location.

This example perfectly lays out the capabilities of a common database.

We will work with the 4 locations involved, to be sure that no one loses data and that all 4 locations have their involvement tracked properly for past engagement and future opportunities for engagement.

As we strive toward the goal of one member record for life, the architecture of the system gives us this opportunity. It also creates numerous duplicate records, so our first 18 months will be spent resolving these duplicates while faith communities will continue to engage and develop relationships with their members.

Finally, the Communications Department at the Chancery is working with the PushPay coaches and app developers in planning for the custom app presence. They have moved along in the design process and expect the custom app to be available in early 2023.
