

Pushpay/ParishStaq Update

All sites and waves are now active in the implementation process.

We now have 47 campuses involved in the phased implementation process! Waves 7.5 -11 recently attended their initial pre-wave meetings.

Our Pilot Wave, Early Adopter Waves, and General Waves 4 and 5 participants continue their implementation. As of the release of this article, we have close to 175,000 individual member profiles from these first 47 sites. After Easter, they will be joined by 47 new campuses in Waves 6 and 7. Expect the number of individual member profiles to double as the databases for Waves 6 and 7 get loaded in the coming months.

As of January 23, four of our campuses are fully out of their PDS databases and are operating solely in ParishStaq. In addition, one of our pilot locations has migrated close to 90% of their recurring online giving families from OSV to the Pushpay Giving platform.

Of the 47 sites active in implementation, seven have set up and launched Pushpay giving to their parishioners. We have two additional sites launching in the next two weeks. It has been wonderful to hear the stories from parishioners and staff on how easy it is to set up recurring gifts on the new platform.

The LEAD app is in heavy use at our two Pilot locations. Their staff and trusted volunteers have been using it to check-in volunteers for their serving opportunities, lookup and connect members with groups and events, and get quick map directions for home visits. Two parishes in the Early Adopter waves have a large group of their staff using the LEAD app as well. This will prove to be an important tool for staff, pastors, and lay leaders.
